

# **Kids' Sewing Supplies List**

### **Notions:**

Sewing/fabric scissors (7" or 8")
Small trimming scissors (5")
Tape measure (60 inches)
Seam gauge (This is a 6" ruler with a slide on it)
Quilter's pins (1 ¾" long with round plastic heads)
Small pin cushion
Seam ripper
2 Chalk pencils (white and blue)
Large safety pin
Small assortment of hand sewing needles
Needle threader (optional)
Craft box to keep notions together or Plastic Zip Lock Bag, 1 gal. size

## **Supplies for Starter Projects**

#### Belt:

- □ Woven webbing or belting 1" wide (waist measurement plus 12 in.)
- □ Two "D" rings 1" wide
- □ Spool of thread\*

### **Small Drawstring Bag:**

- □ Woven cotton fabric 3/8 yd or "fat quarters" from the quilting section
- □ Cording/ribbon 1 1/8 yd or two 18"shoestrings
- Spool of thread to match\*

### **Large Drawstring Bag:**

- □ Woven cotton fabric ½ yd
- □ Cording/ribbon 2 ½ yd or two 36" shoestrings
- □ Spool of thread to match\*

<sup>\*</sup> The best threads are Coats & Clark Dual Duty all purpose cotton-covered polyester or high quality polyester threads made by Mettler or Guttermann. <u>No quilting thread, upholstery thread, buttonhole thread or Sulky threads, please! All are unsuitable for regular machine stitching and difficult for beginners to handle.</u>
