

**COVID-19 Vaccination Third Dose Self-Attestation Form:
Moderately to Severely Immunocompromised Patients**

The CDC is recommending that moderately to severely immunocompromised people receive an additional dose of an mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna). This is NOT for patients who received the J&J/Janssen vaccine as the FDA's recent EUA amendment only applies to mRNA COVID-19 vaccines, as does CDC's recommendation.

By receiving this additional dose, I attest that it has been at least 28 days after being fully vaccinated with a mRNA (Pfizer or Moderna) COVID-19 vaccine and understand that I should talk with my healthcare provider about my medical condition(s), and whether getting an additional dose is appropriate for me.

Please check the high-risk condition that you have and sign at the bottom to attest to your condition and eligibility for the additional dose of vaccine.

Moderately to severely immunocompromised includes people who have:

Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood

Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system

Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)

Advanced or untreated HIV infection

Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids (≥ 20 mg prednisone or equivalent per day) or other drugs that may suppress your immune response
