These measures include but are not limited to:

- Use of cleaning and sanitizing agents on the approved EPA list as effective in preventing the spread of Coronavirus in Tidewater Inn guestrooms and public spaces as well as our food and beverage outlets, spa and catering facilities
- Placing hand sanitizer dispensing stations ASAP in high-traffic, visible areas such as entrances, exits and lobbies
- Increased frequency of touchpoint wipe downs including doorways, railings, door push plates and hardware, remote controls, elevators, etc.
- Encouraging guests and staff alike to follow standard CDC guidelines to stop the spread of infectious agents including vigorous hand washing, limiting interpersonal touching, and staying home if not well
