This is the in-progress 2018(1) CIRRR placement report for Hack Reactor Austin. We provide it here to add additional information and context for current and prospective students. It includes all students who graduated between January and July of 2018. Half of the graduates contained are still within 180 days post-graduation and actively job searching, thus none of these numbers are final.

Note: the “Current” section here is at 68% even while accounting for one third of job seekers who are still within 180 days post-graduation. As such, we expect it to increase, which is reflected in the “Predicted” section.
