

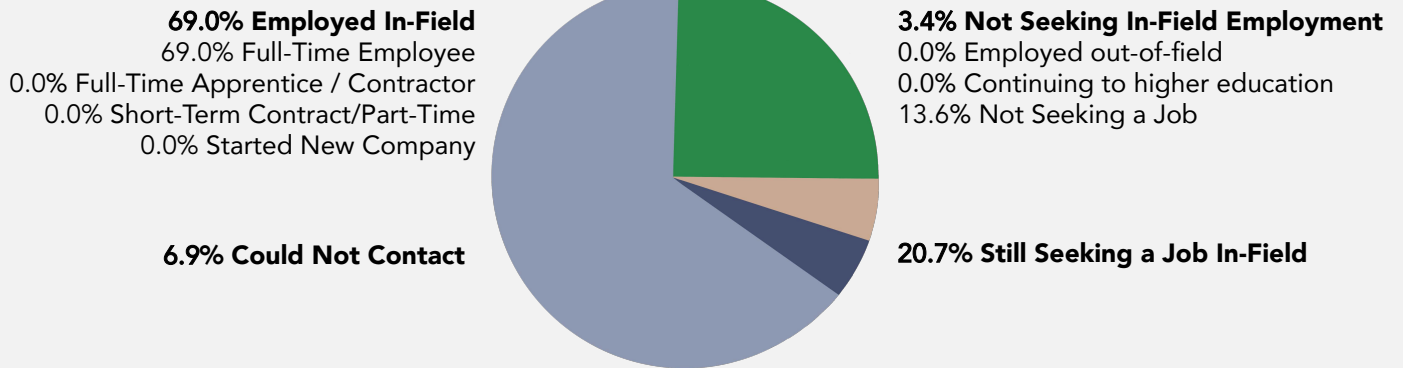

How many students did not intend to seek in-field employment? **17.6%**

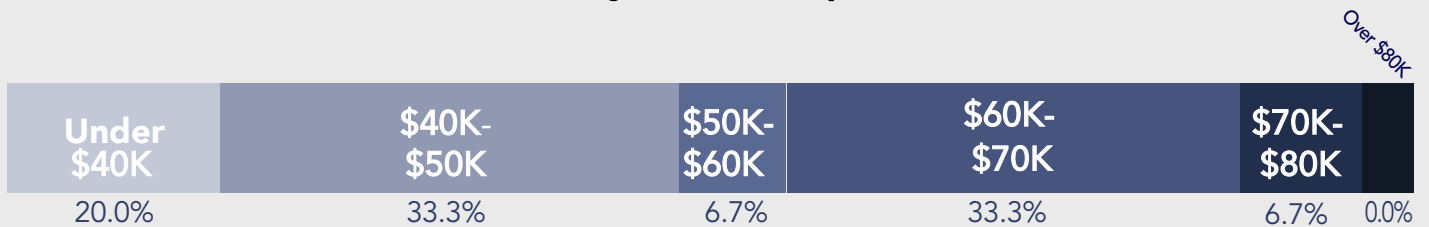
