CAMP DIRECTOR John Gump

John Gump recently completed his 23rd season as head women's volleyball coach at Kutztown University. He is the winningest coach in KU history with a career mark of 394-330. During his time at Kutztown, Coach Gump has led his team to nine appearances in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference Championship Tournament, reaching the semifinals six times. Coach Gump led the Golden Bears to trips to the NCAA Division II National Championship Tournament following the 2006 and 2007 seasons. During his tenure, Kutztown captured the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference East Division title in 2002, 2003, 2005 and 2006. In 32 seasons as a collegiate head coach, he has compiled a record of 605-442, ranking him 9th among active Division II coaches in career victories entering the 2019 season.

Prior to coming to KU, John coached at Division I Lehigh University and at DeSales University. At DeSales, he led his teams to three conference championships and was named coach of the year four times. In 1995, he guided DeSales to a 29-7 record and an invitation to the NCAA Division III National Championship Tournament. Coach Gump was inducted into the DeSales Athletics Hall of Fame in September of 2010.

A staff member since 2006, Cheryl is also the assistant women's volleyball coach at Kutztown University. Her coaching duties at KU include assisting with practice, scouting and recruiting.

Cheryl's other coaching experience includes directing the 18s program for AVA volleyball club, two years as the assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin– Superior as well as with the East End Volleyball Club in Minnesota.

Cheryl played collegiately at Michigan Tech.

Other Information

INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF

The camp staff is comprised of college and club coaches, as well as former and present collegiate players who have demonstrated an ability to effectively teach in a camp setting. The staff will evaluate campers during the first two sessions to place them in groups appropriate to their skill level.

FACILITIES

All activities are held on Kutztown University's campus. Volleyball sessions will be held in the airconditioned Student Recreation Center.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Overnight campers will stay in an air-conditioned University residence hall. Camp staff members will share accommodations and are responsible for supervising campers while in the residence hall. Campers will be sent a medical history form that must be completed and returned <u>prior</u> to participation in either camp. The University Health Center is available to campers needing its services provided a completed medical history form is on file with the camp staff.

Sunday's first session begins at 4:00 p.m. and the final session ends at 9:00 p.m. Monday through Wednesday morning sessions begin at 8:30 and the evening session ends at 8:00. An airconditioned classroom in Keystone Hall will be available for commuting campers to use between sessions.
