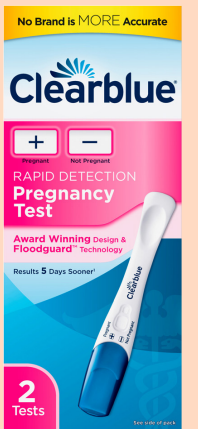

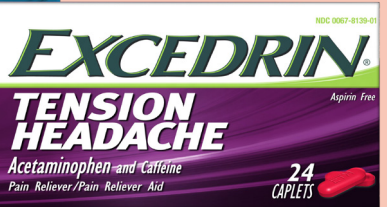

Arthritis Awareness Month

Arthritis is one of the most widespread health conditions in the United States. It affects about one in four adults, or over 58 million Americans. There are several forms of Arthritis with different causes, but Osteoarthritis (OA) is the most common. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Arthritis Foundation, and other partners observe May as the month of Arthritis Awareness.

Arthritis is a general term often used to refer to disorders that affect the joints or cause joint inflammation. There are many types of arthritis, including ankylosing spondylitis, gout, juvenile arthritis, osteoarthritis, psoriatic arthritis, reactive arthritis, and rheumatoid arthritis.

Arthritis affects people of many different ages and backgrounds, from children to older adults. Researchers have found that arthritis is more prevalent in rural areas than urban areas. Although certain risk factors for arthritis, such as weight, can be controlled, it is generally thought that some people inherit a genetic predisposition for arthritis. Arthritis can also be caused by other factors. For example, people in occupations that involve repetitive bending and squatting are often associated with osteoarthritis of the knee.

Symptoms of arthritis can include:

- pain, redness, heat, and swelling in the joints
- trouble moving around
- fever
- weight loss
- breathing problems
- rash or itch

However, these symptoms may also be signs of other illnesses. Doctors typically diagnose arthritis using the patient's medical history, physical examination, X-rays, and blood tests.

Fortunately, medications and surgery can treat arthritis. Treatments vary based upon the person and the type of arthritis. Most arthritis treatments are focused on controlling pain and inflammation, minimizing joint damage, and improving or maintaining physical function and quality of life. Current treatments allow most people with arthritis to continue to lead active lifestyles.
