exhibitors and attendees seriously. We will implement all
current COVID Protocols and CDC Guidelines to provide our
attendees a safe and comfortable meeting environment.
However we can not do this alone – please remember this is
a SHARED RESPONSIBILITY



- The Fort Worth Convention Center has held many events as large or larger than the SCWA EXPO since the first of the year.
- The Fort Worth Convention Center has received the GBAC accreditation which is the Gold Standard in providing a safe environment for events.
 The criteria for receiving this distinct recognition is found in this section.
- The Center is completely sanitized each night following our events.
- The Center has installed the Bipolar Ionization System which is an air sanitizing process.



- The Fort Worth Convention Center currently requires everyone to wear a mask in all public areas such as the lobby; hallways; and restrooms.
- We will not be taking temperatures but the Convention Center and the EXPO will require "self screening". All entrances will have signage that suggests anyone who has a temperature; does not feel well; has a cough; been in recent contact with a COVID positive person - <u>not</u> enter the building.
- Inside the EXPO Hall and all the meeting areas (non public areas) -SCWA will strongly recommend that masks be worn. We cannot be the mask police - but just ask you to help us help others to be comfortable.
- All food services including receptions and lunches will be offered by servers who will be wearing masks and gloves. Other foods may be prepackaged.



- Each individual exhibiting company will be responsible for creating protocols in their individual booths.
- All SCWA registration support will be wearing masks and hand sanitizing will be in abundant supply.
- The Fort Worth Convention Center will provide hand sanitizing stations throughout the public areas and SCWA, compliments of Ver Tech, will provide hand sanitizing in the EXPO; Registration Desk area; General Sessions and all meetings rooms during set up and all hours of the Convention & EXPO.
- Social distancing protocols in your booth will be your responsibility to determine. Again we will recommend in the aisles that everyone respect the social distance of at least three feet.
- The Center will ask for some social distancing in the public areas and also the escalators/elevators
