The State of Cancer in Nigeria





- ◆ 100,000 newly diagnosed cancers yearly (Nigerian Cancer Control Plan, 2018).
- ◆ African women are generally diagnosed with more aggressive cancers.
- ◆ Insufficient research and trials to properly treat the African patient.
- ◆ Risk of late detection as more restrictions on traveling abroad for routine medical exams emerge.
- ◆ By 2030, 80% of new cancer cases worldwide will be in lower-income countries like Nigeria (WHO, 2020).


