Pursuant to the June 2, 2016 Order of the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation ("JPML"), *In re: Interest Rate Swaps Antitrust Litigation*, 16-MD-2704, has been assigned to this Court for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings. 16-MD-2704, Dkt. 1. The JPML Order consolidated *Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund of Chicago et al. v. Bank of America Corporation et al.*, 15 Civ. 9319 (S.D.N.Y) ("CTPF Action") and *Harrison County, Mississippi et al. v. Bank of America Corporation et al.*, 16 Civ. 3282 (N.D. Ill.), while noting that additional tag-along actions were pending in both the Southern District of New York and the Northern District of Illinois.

This Order addresses the four cases brought in this District that have been assigned to this

Court as "related cases" to the CTPF Action under Local Rule 13. These four cases, which

appear below the CTPF Action in the caption above, appear to be within the scope of the

Multidistrict Litigation. It is, therefore, hereby ORDERED that they are transferred to 16-MD-

2704 for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings.

As to the Multidistrict Litigation, the Court will issue an order shortly (1) addressing

various housekeeping matters, (2) scheduling an initial conference in July, and (3) soliciting

counsel's input regarding various case management issues.

Pending the initial conference and further orders of this Court, all deadlines in these actions,

including defendants' time to respond to any of the complaints and all discovery deadlines, are

stayed.

The Clerk of Court is directed to docket this Order in all the above-captioned cases.
