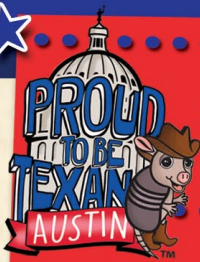

AUSTIN

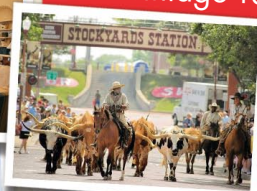

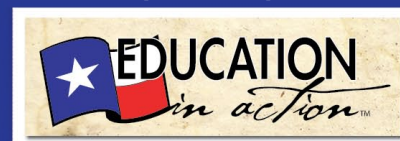
