Cattle Drive Crew

Drag – rides at the back of the herd

Flank – rides to the side of the herd

Point - rides at the head of the herd

Trail Boss – person in charge of the cattle drive

Chuck Wagon – where the cook rides and is ahead of the herd

Wrangler – in charge of the remuda

Remuda – extra horses
