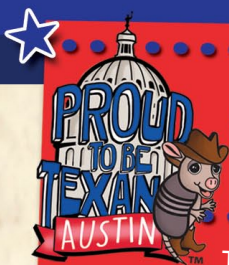

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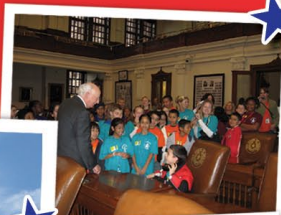




## 4th Grade Social Studies

### AUSTIN

Students learn about Texas history and government with a focus on the regions of Texas, the Texas Revolution, and the legislative process.

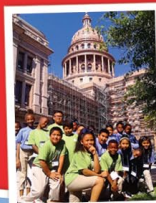

## 4th Grade Social Studies

### SAN ANTONIO/ AUSTIN

Come and take your students with "Lucy the Longhorn" to San Antonio and Austin. Participants experience the making of Texas by walking through the Texas Revolution at the **Battle for Texas: The Experience** museum and **The Alamo** in San Antonio. Then it's off to Austin to learn about the legislative process at the **Texas State Capitol**.

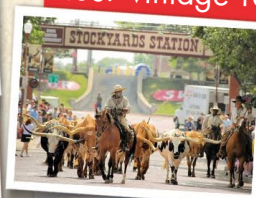

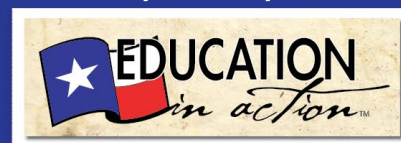
