Parents,

Your student's class is taking part in Education in Action's Texas in the Making Discover Texas Field Trip! We will be traveling on charter buses to visit our beautiful **Texas State Capitol** in Austin and **The Alamo** and the **Witte Museum** in San Antonio to *experience* first-hand what the students are learning in social studies. At the Texas State Capitol, we will learn about our state's unique history and Texas leaders, past and present, and see where Texas laws are made. Then, in San Antonio, the story of the Texas Revolution will come to life as we tour the revered Alamo. At the Witte Museum the students will experience how the people of the lower Pecos region lived long ago through a variety of hands-on activities including creating rock art, processing the lechugilla plant, and using atlatls to "hunt" deer.

What to wear?

Your student will receive their **Discover Texas Field Trip t-shirt** and name tag when they arrive at school the morning of the program. Please have your student wear **TENNIS SHOES** (no flip-flops) as they will be walking a lot. Other than that, **all participants must follow the school's dress code.**

Field Trip Checklist:

- Please label all items your student plans to bring (jacket, camera, etc.).
- Make sure your student gets plenty of rest the night before the field trip.
- Your student must bring FOUR DISPOSABLE DRINKS of no more than 17 ounces each to have with lunch, snack, and dinner.** The morning of the field trip, your student will receive an insulated drink bag to keep.
- Jacket (temperature may be cool on the bus)
- Medications, if applicable (discuss with your student's teacher)
- Digital or disposable camera (optional). Digital camera may NOT be on a cell phone.

Please do NOT bring:

- ★ Cell phones, tablets, or any other electronics - Stand-alone digital cameras are the only exception.
- ★ Backpacks, pillows, or blankets
- ★ Money – The program fee includes everything the participants need for the day and program souvenirs. Participants do not visit gift shops or cafes.
