2019 Energy Efficient New Home Construction Rebate

Congratulations on your new home!!! Was it certified an ENERGY STAR home during the construction process? If so, HILCO Electric Cooperative is happy to provide you with a \$500.00 rebate.

Any home, single family, modular, manufactured, even multi-family, with three stories or less can be certified as an Energy Star home if it meets EPA guidelines for energy efficiency standards. Energy Star homes are at least 15% more energy efficient than those built to the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code.

Energy efficiencies are typically obtained based on a combination of choices used in the home's construction such as the type of insulation installed, type of heating and cooling systems used, appliances and windows installed, even lighting choices can improve efficiencies. To receive the rebate, simply complete and attach this form to a copy of the Energy Star Certificate or a Home Energy Rating Standards (HERS) certificate with an overall score of 86 or less, and submit the documents to HILCO. Rebate request must be postmarked within sixty days from the date of the certification/completion of construction and homes must have closed after January 1, 2019.
