

Pecha Kucha Presentation Instructions

“Two minutes six slides 20 seconds a slide” with a 5 second overview slide.

Please prepare a six slide Pecha Kucha presentation on your past, present and future. The presentation has to be timed within PowerPoint. Share with us two minutes about yourself.

The red words are the only words that can be on each of the slides.

PAST (slide one, two) some ideas hometown, high school, your prom date, your first steps, favorite cartoon character, parents, elementary school, symbols of your culture, religion, zip code, etc. Anything you want but it needs to be busy.

PRESENT (slide three, slide four) some ideas: job, organizations, family, vacations, credit rating, involvement, causes, major, BFF (your new best friend forever), Greek organizations, clubs, your room, residence hall, favorite place in Indiana or Johnstown, Punx, worst professor/best, whatever

FUTURE (slide three) career, job, geography local, movie star or band member you want to be with, anything you envision yourself in the future..

The pecha kucha will be the seven slides. Obviously, the very first slide will have your name, class, date, and assignment name on it.

The criteria will be-

Was the PowerPoint timed for 20 seconds a slide?

Did the speaker and slide presentation end at the same time?

Was the speaker able to communicate (voice, tone, eye contact, enthusiasm, mannerisms, etc.) effectively to the audience?

Slide 1 and 2 Past-did the slides contain an adequate amount of images, pictures, illustrations, visuals, etc., to meet the objectives of a Pecha Kucha slide and enough dialogue to match it to keep the audience interested?

Slide 3 and 4 Present-did the slides contain an adequate amount of images, pictures, illustrations, visuals, etc., to meet the objectives of a Pecha Kucha slide and enough dialogue to match it to keep the audience interested?

Slide 5 and 6 Future-did the slides contain an adequate amount of images, pictures, illustrations, visuals, etc., to meet the objectives of a Pecha Kucha slide and enough dialogue to match it to keep the audience interested?

Bottom Line-the student was asked to discuss the past, present and future about themselves with ease?
