Instructions to students

Hypothetical Situation: you are on the management team for a top ranked national sports-broadcasting network. The business model includes on-air programming, both digital and printed magazines, blogs contributing thought leadership for key trends in the sports marketplace as well as a well-developed social media presence. Overall, the company creates large volumes of content for an engaged, highly brand loyal audience.

The IT department gave you a report which shows a rapidly growing trend of the artificial intelligence (AI) writing tool ChatGPT being used by your employees. You have been asked to write an email addressing the use of this technology. Consider how the use of this AI technology can affect credibility, authenticity, plagiarism, efficiency, originality and professionalism of your corporate brand. How can you thoughtfully and considerately address the potentially valid while also disruptive use of this technology?

Audience: your email will be distributed to the whole company. Consider your tone when writing to an audience of your peers who you frequently interact with.

Task: collaborate as a team of two or three students. One student can submit in Blackboard but please include all student names on the top of the assignment. Compose an engaging statement that treats employees as grown-ups who can exercise intelligent judgement. Address the following points:

- Can employees use this technology when creating content?
- If they are allowed to use the technology when is it acceptable?
- If they are not allowed to use the technology will you block computer access or scan content to assess if AI was used to create?
- Any applicable examples or additional information that should be conveyed to employees?

Successful responses will consider:

- Tone and language
- Organization of information including formatting options like bulleted lists or a key summary section
- Aligning the concepts towards overall company goals while communicating interpersonal respect
- Potentially including professionalism components
- Assessing the best way to open and close the email
- Addressing what you know about your audience and what they care about
- Making the information relevant to your audience
- Assessing if your message has been received and understood
