Assignment Directions

Discourse at Work: Open-access digital videos for Business Communication instructors

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- 1. Students are divided into 4 groups.
- 2. The instructor chooses 4 different videos from the Discourse at Work website (see www.professorsloan.com for topics), assigning one to each group.
- 3. Each group watches their respective video, taking extensive notes. The viewing can take place during class or may be assigned as homework.
- 4. Each group collaborates to write a properly formatted memo to the class that addresses the following questions:
 - a. What are the salient "takeaways" from your video?
 - b. How does it connect with our course readings/conversations?
 - c. What further questions are raised?
- 5. Memos are shared, serving as the impetus for broader class discussion.
- 6. Memos are submitted to the instructor for assessment/evaluation.
