## **40 Years of Innovation**

Introducing 2021 Service Excellence Awardee Susan Bressler, MD

It's been one innovation after another for Dr. Susan Bressler during her 40 years as an ophthalmologist. When she entered the field, no treatment existed for Age-Related Macular Degeneration (AMD)—the number one cause of blindness in adults 50 and older in the developed world. Early in her career laser therapy was developed, which wasn't perfect but was rewarding, because, says Dr. Bressler, "We went from nothing to at least having something." Next came photodynamic therapy, which she was directly involved in developing. Then, in the early 2000s came drugs that are injected into people's eyes with remarkable outcomes. "We can stop vision loss in 90 percent of people and recover lost vision in 30-40 percent of people suffering from wet neovascular AMD," says Dr. Bressler. And the innovation isn't over! Dr. Bressler says drugs are on the horizon that will last longer in the eye so that instead of having to go into an office every month for injections, patients will only have to go a few times a year.
