

How to choose your piano registration level:

To ensure the best possible experience in piano classes, please *carefully consider* these detailed descriptions and **consult with your piano teacher** before choosing your registration level.

Level 1: Five-finger patterns with little hand movement, very simple hands-together playing, easy note reading, simple rhythms. This is roughly equivalent to Faber Primer and Level 1 books. Musikgarten keyboard 1 and 2, choose this level.

Level 2: Some hand position changes, mostly easy note reading in a few major keys. Must have experience with eighth note rhythms. This is roughly equivalent to Faber books 2A and 2B. Musikgarten keyboard 3, choose this level.

Level 3: Right and left hands starting to move independently, multiple chords in a measure, rhythms becoming a bit more complicated, reading notes in most major and some minor keys. This is roughly equivalent to Faber books 3A and 3B.

Level 4: Scales moving up and down in both hands, faster tempos, more complex chords and more complicated rhythms. This is equivalent to Faber book 4.
