Dispensing Pharmacy: OTC products, blister packaging for daily medications, medication therapy management, wellness support, patient education, braces and shoe inserts and medication synchronization.

Health screenings: cholesterol, blood glucose, hemoglobin A1C, weight, BMI, % body fat, blood pressure, bone density, dermatology

Preventive health services: health risk assessment, tobacco cessation, immunizations

PHARMACY FAQ

Q: What insurance do you accept?

A: We accept most prescription insurance plans. If you are on your parents' insurance, we can take care of you!

Q: How do I transfer my prescriptions?

A: Just call us or email us with the following information:

- You can request a transfer on our website! Go to www.onuhealthwisepharmacy.com. Then select the "refill" orange button on the homepage and follow the prompts.
- You can also call us at 419-772-3784. We will need to know what prescriptions(s) you need transferred and where those prescription(s) were filled last.

Q: Do students get a discount?

A: Yes. Students get a 5% discount on OTC items when they show their student ID.

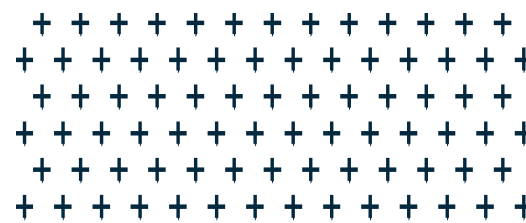
Q: How do I request a refill?

A: The various methods below are secure and reach us immediately.

- Call us at 419-772-DRUG (3784). You may speak to a person, use the automated system to type in your RX number, or leave a message for the pharmacist.
- Use our website www.onuhealthwisepharmacy.com. You can create an account, look at your profile, request refills and requests transfers.
- Use our mobile app. You may download the app by following the prompts on the website or search for "My Community Pharmacy" in App or Google Play stores. You can find our pharmacy by using the zip code.

Q: What happens if I need my prescription during breaks or the summer?

A: If we can fill your prescription for a 90-day supply to help get you through breaks/summer, we will! We can also mail your prescriptions to you during breaks and the summer so you don't have to hassle with getting your prescription transferred.



Q: What do I need to bring to the pharmacy to fill a prescription?

A: Your prescription, your pharmacy insurance card (or a picture of the card), and your basic info (date of birth, address, phone number, allergies).

IMMUNIZATIONS FOR FRESHMEN

ONU requires MMR, Hepatitis B and tetanus booster.

Hepatitis B (Engerix):

- Recommended for ages 7- 18 years old to complete three dose vaccination series.
- Recommended for adults 19 years and older who are at high risk or wish to be protected from hepatitis B.

Required for all pharmacy, nursing, clinical lab science, and athletic training majors

Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis)

- Recommended for 11 years and older who have not received Tdap or for who vaccine status is unknown and those with recent deep and dirty wound with lack of evidence of tetanus vaccination in the last 5 years.
- Tetanus booster due every 10 years with at least one dose of Tdap as booster.
- Recommended for all healthcare personnel.
- Required for all incoming students to be up-to-date.

MMR

- Recommended those at high-risk, including students entering college, receive a total of two doses.
- Required for all incoming students.

Additional vaccines for young adults

Meningitis

- MCV4 (Menatra)
- Meningococcal group B (Bexsero or Trumenba)

HPV (Gardasil 9)

Hepatitis A (Havirix)

Most insurances cover vaccines at the pharmacy with no copay. To receive a vaccination today, just complete the vaccine specific form and provide a copy of your prescription insurance card. You do not need to make an appointment to be vaccinated. We also have fact sheets on each vaccine if you would like more information. We will offer flu shots to all students, faculty and staff for the 2020-21 flu season starting in September.
