

Visitor Policy

Due to COVID-19, we are temporarily not allowing visitors at this time.

This update to our visitor policy is for the safety of our community, patients, physicians, and employees.

The only exceptions to our no-visitor policy are:

- One healthy parent at a time for pediatric and neonatal intensive care unit patients.
- One healthy birth partner for labor, delivery, postpartum and recovery units.
- One healthy visitor for all patients having medically necessary procedures, medically necessary out-patient surgery, GI lab, radiology, catheterization lab.
- One healthy visitor for all emergency department patients.
- One healthy visitor for patients who lack the capacity/competence, or the DPOA would fall under the special exception.

Exceptions to this policy may be made for those patients receiving end-of-life care or who have extraordinary circumstances, in which case the nursing supervisor will make the determination.

Any visitor who exhibits signs and symptoms of illness may not visit hospitalized patients.

Additionally, all tours, classes and events are cancelled until further notice.
