

Built in 1888 by John Kleck, The Saloon was a cornerstone of Fredericksburg's social life. Its limestone façade, wrought-iron railings, and distinctive cement elephant above the entrance has set it apart as one of the town's most memorable landmarks.

The Saloon thrived until Prohibition in 1920, when the nationwide ban on alcohol forced its closure. Over the next fifty years, it served as a grocery store, barbershop, and even a car dealership.

Today, it's The Saloon once again, carrying on the name and spirit of Fredericksburg's frontier past.
