Orphan Care

Two hundred fifty thousand orphans struggle to survive in Uganda. Twenty percent of children ages 6-17 are orphans; half of them have lost parents to HIV/AIDS. No other nation has a higher percent orphaned by AIDS. The Lord's Resistance Army left many others parentless. Who will care for them?

Healthcare

One in seven children in Uganda die by age five. This sobering statistic reveals a tremendous need for health care in Uganda. Our 180-bed hospital and dental care center can help change that for the community in Northern Uganda.

Empowerment

Restoration Gateway's vision for empowerment includes development of skills training programs so Ugandans can learn vocational and other skills that will enable them to get good jobs.

Ministry to the Church

Restoration Gateway believes God's people are His chosen vessel to carry out his purposes on earth. A ministry to the body of Christ is a core component of Restoration Gateway's philosophy.

- Amy Grant headlining our record-breaking annual fundraising celebration was clearly a God favored event. At the event, more people learned about the basic structure and story of Restoration Gateway and many people sponsored children as their entry into RG involvement. Sponsors and donors made significant contributions to fulfilling the vision.
- Our board has been actively upgrading our child sponsorship program:
 - The board made a visit to a similar ministry in Uganda for benchmarking purposes.

- We have completed our “Excellence in Giving” recommendations in preparation for additional funding from institutions and individual donors.
- We are adding to our accounting and administration staff to serve our stakeholders better and continue to improve our accountability measures.

God has a plan for 2019 for RG. While there is little doubt that when dealing with an African nation there is potential for delays, frustration, and difficulties. God continues to work His vision in spite of the challenges that come our way. Praise the Lord!
