The Treasure Tome: A Trove of Knowledge

Opal: the Opulent and Ocular

The superstition that Opal is bad luck to have unless it's your birthstone is deeply ingrained in modern western civilization. However, this belief has relatively recent roots that stem from a 19th century novel. According to Bruce Knuth, author of Gems in Myth, Legend and Lore, historians believe that this superstition

originated in 1829 with the publication of Sir Walter Scott's novel, Anne of Geiserstein. In this novel an enchanted princess lives a charmed life, but during a blessed event water splashes onto an Opal worn in her hair and puts out the play-of-color. Since Opals are said to show the mood of the wearer, when the Opal's light was extinguished so was the princess' will to live. A half a century later, the King of Spain gave his queen a beautiful Opal ring for their wedding day. Shortly thereafter the queen, queen mother, king's sister, and his sister-in-law each died. The exact order of events is unclear, but eventually the King met the same fate. This led many in Spain to believe the gem was unlucky or even evil.

However, as entertaining as this story is, all of these deaths occurred during the time of the great cholera epidemic in Spain, and thus could be attributed to the natural progression of contagions. Long before these superstitions arose, Opals were considered an auspicious stone to carry and wear. In ancient Rome, the stone was believed to be the most favored of the gods because of its beauty and became a symbol of joy, hope, nobility, and power. Many cultures across the globe associated Opal with the eyes, believing they improved physical and intuitive visionary prowess. In addition, the ancient Greeks believed that having an Opal on your person could make you invisible (1). This could be due to the fact that some translucent Opals will become almost invisible when submerged in water. Precious Opals are also

believed to reflect the mood of the wearer by the flashes of color present and also help to balance out one's mood. Precious Opals are associated with the Fifth Element, which is also sometimes



referred to as the Storm Element. This is especially appropriate for Precious Opal because of one of its origin stories. In this story the Storm God became violently jealous of the Rainbow God and so struck him down. As the Rainbow God fell to the Earth his body shattered and became petrified, turning into Precious Opal. Some believe that Opals form from lightning striking the Earth and become trapped in the stone (1). In either case, Precious Opals are closely associated with power and elemental energies due to their representation of all four elements (Earth - Solid Stone, Air -Amorphous, Fire - As Play-of-Color and Water - Within the Stone). For this reason they are often used to connect and influence the natural world. For Clarification, Opal that shows the desired playof-color is known as "Precious Opal," while Opals without this distinct color phenomenon are known as "Common Opals." Playof-color should not to be confused with "fire" which refers to scintillation in faceted stones or "Opalescence" which refers to the foggy glow found in Opal & Moonstone. For Precious Opals to form there are 4 conditions that must be simultaneously met, making its formation relatively rare.

In addition to the play-of-color present in a small percentage of the world's Opal reserves, each Opal has what is known as its "body color" and refers to the base or background color of the Opal itself. For example, Opals can have a

red-orange body color making it "Fire Opal" or deep red would be "Cherry Opal" while brown might be referred to as "Chocolate Opal". Other body colors can include yellow, green, blue, violet, pink, white, and black. Opal, the Queen of Gemstones, is not technically a mineral since it does not have an atomic crystalline lattice, but it is a definitive gemstone because of how rare and beautiful it is.



Opal is a rock composed of silica spheres with interstitial molecular water, which generally only forms as low temperature, secondary deposits at the Earth's surface. The water in Opal makes it sensitive to heat because as the temperature rises, the water becomes volatile and attempts to escape causing the Opal to fracture. As water flows through a silica-rich rock, silica gets leached and redeposited as Opal along fissures and cavities. Because Opal begins as a gel-like substance it can even replace organic matter to form Opalized fossils. Whether one chooses to belief in young superstitions or ancient lore, Opals are inarguably one of the visions of the gem kingdom. (1) Knuth, Bruce. Gems in

This is an Agua Nueva Agate from Chihuahua, Mexico. These agates are named after their location; in this case after the ranch they are found on. Agua Nueva Agate formed in an andesite lava which is silica rich.





The claim that these Aqua Nueva Agates are from is producing very little gem quality material, and will no longer be dug commercially after this year. We, here at Nature's Treasures, try to bring you agate such as this from all over the world, allowing you to enhance your collection.

A Note on Agates:

Silica is the key component to agate formation since it belongs to the quartz family made up of SiO2. Because of their beauty and durability, agates have been used since the Neolithic as tools, jewelry, tableware and decor for thousands of years. Although agate has been used for ages, new world agates have only been mined recently and many varieties are mined out.
