

Town Total Compounding Centers, LLC (Woodbury, NY) seeks Compounding Pharmacist to compound and dispense medications as prescribed by doctors, by calculating, weighing, measuring, and mixing ingredients, or overseeing those activities. Formulate new compounded medications by entering new master formulas. Provide patients with information and advice regarding drug interactions, side effects, dosage, and proper medication storage. Advise physicians and other health practitioners on the selection, dosage, interactions, and side effects of medications. Review prescriptions to assure accuracy, to ascertain the needed ingredients, and to evaluate their suitability. Communicate detailed medical information to patients or family members and advise patients on effects of health conditions or treatments. Maintain records, such as pharmacy files, patient profiles, charge system files, inventories, control records. Perform hormone replacement and other consultations, via remote call or in person. Plan, implement, or maintain procedures for mixing, packaging, or labeling pharmaceuticals according to policy and legal requirements, to ensure quality, security, and proper disposal. Assess the identity, strength, or purity of medications. Prepare sterile solutions or injections and other medications. Apply knowledge of and demonstrate ability to adhere to the current USP Chapters <795>, <797> and <800>. Collaborate with other health care professionals to plan, monitor, review, or evaluate the quality or effectiveness of drugs or drug regimens, providing advice on drug applications or characteristics. Order and purchase pharmaceutical supplies, medical supplies, or drugs, maintaining stock and storing and handling properly. Analyze prescribing trends to monitor patient compliance and to prevent excessive usage or harmful interactions. Advise customers on the selection of medication brands, medical equipment, or healthcare supplies. Manage pharmacy operations, including the supervision of staff, performance of administrative duties, and the buying/selling of nonpharmaceutical merchandise. Contact insurance companies to resolve billing issues. Refer patients to other health professionals or agencies when appropriate. Complete clinical checks to include current prescription medications, OTC's or vitamins, allergies or drug reactions, chronic diseases, and medical devices. Adhere to all company health and safety policies and procedures.
