

#### Dancer Drop Off and Pick Up Information

- All dancers must be checked in with our staff/volunteer... please have one parent to check in your dancer.
- Parents of dancers in level 2 and under will receive a number tag at check in
- DO NOT LOSE YOUR TAG! You will need this to check out your dancer. All dancers will have a number assigned to them
- A staff/volunteer will guide your dancer to their dressing room to get ready for the show.
- Please have your dancer's hair an make up done before arriving to the theatre
- ALL COSTUMES MUST ARRIVE IN A GARMENT BAG... Please have your child's name labeled on EVERYTHING they bring
- Arrive before your assigned call time to check in as the line could be long
- After the show is over, please send one parent to check out your dancer with the tag, A volunteer will bring your dancer to the front for check out
- DANCERS WILL REMAIN BACKSTAGE FOR THE ENTIRE SHOW
- No parents are allowed backstage unless permission is given by the director

# Show tights/shoes?

Ballet – pink tights, pink ballets shoes... boys- thin white socks, black ballet shoes

Tap- black tights (tap 3, int/adv tap, adult tap), tan tights (pre tap, tap ½), black tap shoes... boys- thin black socks, black tap shoes

Jazz- tan tights, tan jazz shoes

Contemporary- tan tights, tan cont. socks

Lyrical- tan tights, barefoot

Musical Theatre/Hip Hop-Tan tights, black jazz shoes

\*ALL SHOES AND TIGHTS MUST BE CLEAN WITH NO HOLES

### Costumes

- Once costumes arrive your dancer will have a fitting in class. If your dancer needs alterations of any kind you may be asked to take your costume early to have that done.
- ALL COSTUMES WILL GO HOME WITH DANCERS ON PICTURE DAY
- Dancers/parents are responsible for bringing costumes to and from rehearsal/show in a garment bag
- The costumes are yours to keep after the show! DO NOT WEAR THEM BEFORE!
