Overview

Teen Court is an innovative alternative to traditional juvenile court proceedings for first-time nonviolent offenders. It is designed to promote values of justice, fairness, and safety in the lives of adolescents. Teen Court intends to help other teens accept responsibility for their actions and holds them accountable for their behavior. In addition, Teen Court seeks to provide youth with better decision making skills to avoid further contact with the Juvenile Court System.

Teen Court is made up of selected teens from all over Wood County. Teen Court consists of a Teen Prosecutor, Teen Defense, Jury members, Bailiff and Jury Foreman, with an adult hearing officer presiding.

Representatives from the Wood County Prosecutor's Office will choose individuals, based on applications and interviews, from Wood County to serve as members of the Teen Court. Those selected will be notified of the details regarding their term.

Teen Court Calendar: Winter/Spring 2019

Teen Court meets twice per month throughout each six-month term.* One meeting each month is an Enhancement Meeting designed to promote group cohesion and service learning while the other meeting held during the month is the actual Courtroom Session. Below you will find a schedule of the upcoming term. Teen Court members are required to make a commitment to attend each meeting during their selected time of service. It is the responsibility of Teen Court members to provide or arrange transportation to and from Teen Court.

The Teen Court winter/spring term selection process will consist of an application review and an interview. Applicants selected for interviews will be contacted by December 21st at the latest in order to schedule their interviews. Interviews will take place December 19th – December 28th. Each applicant will be contacted regarding a decision via e-mail on or before January 3rd.
