

The Texas Children in Nature Network is a unique non-profit organization that connects hundreds of partners under the shared mission to ensure equitable access and connection to nature for all children in Texas.

Texas Children in Nature Network is committed to collaborating with partners across the state to achieve better outcomes for children. Research shows that children who regularly spend time in nature are healthier, happier, and perform better in school. Nature improves their mental and physical health, promoting child development and social-emotional learning, and helps them become the conservation leaders of tomorrow. But today, most children spend only a few minutes per day outdoors. This lack of connection with nature negatively affects their health, well-being, and development in significant ways.*

Texas Children in Nature Network has eleven regional collaboratives across the state that learn from one another, leverage each other's strengths, and work together to amplify the impact of our work to engage and connect children with nature.

- Helping support Nature Everywhere initiatives in Austin, San Antonio, Fort Worth, and in five school districts in South Texas. Nature Everywhere is an initiative with the National League of Cities, Kaboom!, and Children & Nature Network working to bring more nature into our communities. TCiNN continues to focus on bringing this program to more cities across the state.
- Supporting Nature Smart Libraries across the state, including our work with the Library Explorer Adventure Packs (LEAP) nature backpack program in the Rio Grande Valley, Dallas, and Houston Metro-area.
- We provide key resources and professional development for practitioners across the state through our webinars, teacher workshops, and our annual Summit.
