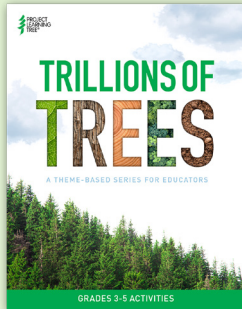
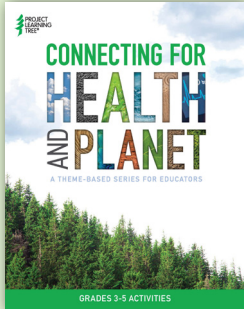

- 5** PLT connects students and educators to nature, providing social, emotional, and health benefits.



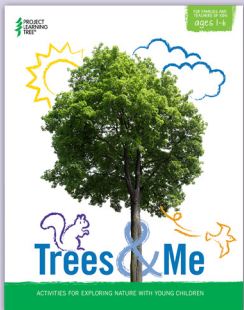

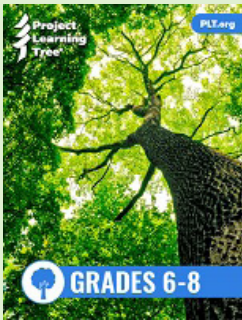
DIGITAL ACTIVITY COLLECTIONS

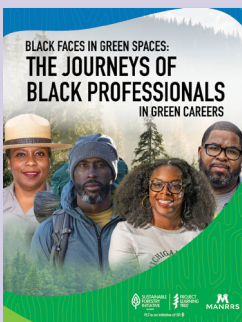
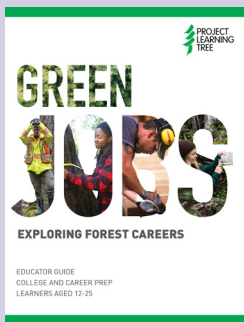
ACTIVITY GUIDES
