LEGAL

- Fight the Needmore decision—request a rehearing on Needmore
- Fight the Electro Purification Contested Case (even more important now because of Needmore)
- Fight any and all large-volume permit applications that threaten aquifer levels

COMMUNITY CAMPAIGN AGAINST SPECIAL CONDITIONS IN PERMITS

- Message: Reduce or deny, no entitlements.
- Need community involvement/participation at BSEACD board meetings
- Messaging in press (letter to editors)
- One-on-one communications with District staff and/or board members

ADVOCATING FOR SUSTAINABLE/SAFE MANAGEMENT OF THE TRINITY AQUIFER

- Moratorium on new permit applications in the Middle Trinity Aquifer
- Continue to work with BSEACD staff and other stakeholders to fundraise and develop numerical model
- Engage landowners to take part in BSEACD's periodic well monitoring program
- Engage with BSEACD and HTGCD boards on adopting a Desired Future Condition (DFC) that is measurable and based on sustainability (not 25 feet of drawdown), ideally before the next DFC adoption cycle in 2021
- Create stakeholder group to address sustainable management goals
- Conservation/more protective drought triggers/rainwater
