

(these procedures are in addition to the school's normal NAEYC guidelines and practices found in the family handbook)

The school's commitment to keep all the children, staff, and families safe is our biggest priority. Throughout this pandemic, the school has set guidelines following the state's regulatory agencies. At this time, the school is returning to the guidelines put in place during the summer programming and before the most recent surge in cases.

Now that cases are down and the city of Austin is in stage 3, the school will resume these guidelines effective Oct. 18, 2021.

1. Preventing the Spread of COVID-19

- 1. Vaccinated teachers and parents
 - a. Vaccinated teachers and parents will no longer be required to wear masks, but have the right to wear masks if so desired.
- 2. Unvaccinated teachers and parents
 - a. Unvaccinated parents must wear masks
 - b. Unvaccinated teachers must wear masks in classrooms and common areas within the school, i.e. teacher resource room and office.
- 3. Masks are not required outside for any teachers

2. Health Screenings

- Temperature checks must be performed by parents/guardians on themselves and their child (ren) each day before dropping off, and on parents/guardians before picking up your child. No person entering the facility can have a fever of **100.4 or above** degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. Staff will visually check if any of these signs or symptoms are seen or made aware of at drop-off:

Cough	Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing	Chills
Muscle pain	Headache	Sore throat
Diarrhea	Repeated shaking with chills	Loss of taste or smell

□ No person will be allowed entry if any of the above symptoms are seen, unless of a diagnosed childhood virus that is spreading in the school.

3. Drop off and Pick up

- 1. All gates are accessible to parents for any classroom.
- 2. Parents will stand outside the classroom door and not enter the classroom at drop off and 3:30 PM pick up.
- 3. Fun Zone Pick Up time: After 3:30 PM
 - a. Pick up will happen at either the classroom door or on the playground.
 - b. If children are on the playground, parents may enter the classroom to gather their child's belongings.
