The School Board accepted Reliant Communications Proposal for new door locks and security cameras. Starting next week they will install wi-fi door strikes and keypads on all 20 doors (including the outside bathrooms, storage room door, and Kleberg Hall). Once installed, I will provide parents with codes to access the classrooms.

This upgrade will add an extra layer of security. The doors will automatically lock when they close, but can be open from the inside without a code. The cameras will be on the outside of each building and can be monitored from the school office.
