## Where Alternatives Began

Hillsboro Pharmacy has served the people of western Washington County since 1873, when Dr. F.A. Bailey, a Confederate Army doctor who came to Oregon after the Civil War, was the proprietor.

The original location was in the Morgan Building at the northeast corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> & Main. Although we no longer accept chickens or eggs as payment on accounts, we still know many of our customers by name and offer them friendly, yet professional service.

The soda fountain, established before the previous turn of the century, is one of the few remaining in the state.
