# Heart of the West



## **EQUESTRIAN THERAPY**



The heart of Carousel Ranch has and always will be our equestrian therapy program. We are currently in the process of adding 10+ new students to the program. There is truly no better feeling than seeing our kids on horses each week working to reach new goals and defy the odds.

Carousel Ranch's program design is unique, working to create individualized programs for every student while continuously adapting to their specific needs as they change over time. The program utilizes the sport of vaulting (gymnastics on a moving horse), English, and Western riding. Each child is served individually (no group lessons), with up to four people working with each child. We strive to work on the same things that are being targeted in traditional forms of therapy, taking it out of a clinical setting and creating an atmosphere where therapy is disguised as fun.

The goals and benefits are different for every child, depending on their individual needs. The movement of the horse causes an inherent response from the child, "WE RIDE TO FLY. TO FEEL. TO LAUGH. TO PROVE THEM WRONG. TO FEEL STRONG. TO LOVE AND TO BE LOVED BACK. WE RIDE TO LIVE."

relaxing muscles that are tight, increasing tone in muscles that are weak, building balance, coordination and control, increased motor skills, improvements in behavior and sensory processing while building confidence, self-esteem and social interaction. From the big to the small, each achievement reminds us of the amazing effect that horses have on our children.



"We were on the wait list for a while and it was completely worth the wait because Arrow has excelled and grown as a person in so many ways that's transferred into his whole entire life at school and at home. He's more excited to be engaged with people and I think being here gives him the confidence to do that, which was totally unexpected. Usually quiet and reserved in social environments, Arrow has begun to be more talkative and eager to try new things. Not only at the Ranch but in everyday life.

Another positive of being here is his new confidence to try different things. I get excited because he was just so quiet and wouldn't put himself out there. So now when he does, I just think back to how far he's come and obviously we're doing something right now that we weren't doing the past 10 years. That's making me see who he is. He's like a little comedian and I never knew that. I'm learning new things about him all the time and what's again so unexpected is who he is and getting to know him better. I think everybody here has encouraged him to be that person. Carousel Ranch has benefited him in ways I didn't even consider. With every session he grows a little more, which helps my goal as a parent, which is for him to reach his full potential."

## **READY TO WORK!**

At age 22, young adults with disabilities "age out" of the educational system. This can be a disorienting and disempowering event that alters their routine, isolates them from friends and mentors, and leaves them without a daily purpose and place to be. We strive to meet each student where they are, working to meet their needs while challenging them to try new things, set goals and achieve them. Together, we build on their interest and skills helping each student discover their passions and potential.

To date, RTW has served over 100 participants, completed 29RTW Level I classes, and supported 47 students in the RTW Level II program and 31 in the Academy program at COC. 66% of those participating in Level II have secured paid employment and/or Paid Internships. Community business partners include Santa Clarita Concrete, Holiday Inn Express, Starbucks, Pet Supplies Plus, Six Flags, Chevron, SCVTV, JT Resources, AMS Fulfillment and Bluemark, etc.

# Dom Twigg

"My son Dominic...excuse me, I mean Dom... has very clear aspirations to work in a movie theater. Not that I don't believe in my son, but I'm a realist, and after years of behavior training in the school district, he still did not seem ready for the social, emotional and technical challenges of a job. He was ready to complete his years in school and move on, but again my mind was racing with questions and fears. Where next? How to make his dream a reality? Is he ready?

I found Ready To Work at Carousel Ranch and after one phone call with Camryn, I felt hopeful and motivated, so I presented it to Dom. He was skeptical, he had zero intentions or interest in any more "classes". We visited and he interviewed at Carousel and he was very impressed and more than willing to give it a try. So he started Level One and was excited to learn how to do tasks at work, even mucking the stalls! He was excited and proud of his uniform and his responsibilities with the garden and even the classroom time. He made a new friend in his group. He was well prepared for his first mock job interview and was invited to continue on with Level 2 of Ready To Work.

He is now in level 2, and we are both learning valuable lessons for work and life. For example, when Dom is having an issue with a work problem, he has been trained to take that problem to his boss at work, not his Mom. Likewise, I am learning to let him find solutions to his problems in the right places, even if he suffers a consequence.

My expectations with Ready To Work at Carousel Ranch have been far exceeded! Dom still has more learning and practice ahead, but I am feeling more than confident that he will have the skills and means to find and keep a job that will give him purpose. I am so grateful to have found this program and Hannah, Alejandra and Camryn have helped Dom to grown and mature as a man with independence."

# CAROUSEL RANCH COLLABORATION BRINGING EQUESTRIAN THERAPY TO UKRAINE

There are moments in life that are just meant to be...times when things align so perfectly and allow us to reach a new level. For Carousel Ranch and all of us who work here – this was one of those moments. Just days before Heart of the West, we received an email from Nastya Popandopulos who lives in Kyiv, Ukraine. She shared that she and Victoria Kokaleva were in the process of developing an equine therapy program aimed at providing support and healing to Ukrainian war veterans and children who have been directly affected by the frontlines. She shared her vision of a creating a program that provides a safe and nurturing environment where participants can interact with horses, fostering a sense of connection, trust, and empowerment. A place where they aim to address various trauma, anxiety, and stress, while promoting emotional resilience and personal growth.

In early September, an initial zoom meeting with Denise formed a true connection. Nastya shared that she herself had been experiencing some mental health issues from the constant daily stress. She explained how Victoria invited her to her ranch and told the story of how that day, being on a horse for the first time – was the first time she had felt calm since the war began. And in that moment, she knew that she wanted to share that feeling with others.

Nastya was coming to the US in mid-September, invited by the US Department of State as the one chosen delegate from Ukraine – where she would be part of the IVLP (International Visitor Leadership Program) Social Entrepreneur program. Though it didn't seem possible at first – they were able to extend her visa so that she could come to Carousel Ranch for two weeks to train.

Nastya quickly became part of the Carousel Ranch family and each member of our team bonded with her in such an immediate and unexpected way. She learned quickly, participated in the programs, worked in lessons and was able to learn so much. She collaborated with all of the Ranch staff, while working closely with Denise, Becky and Taylor to establish Victory Center in Kyiv. This groundbreaking initiative responds to the invasion in Ukraine…literally transforming trauma into triumph.

Though she returned to Ukraine at the end of October, the relationships continue. She and Denise continue to work on her non-profit status, program development and fundraising concepts while Becky continues to be there to provide guidance on working with students. In addition while here, we introduced her to Bob Horrell from Military Animal Project (a long-time friend of Carousel Ranch) who will advise her and offer guidance for working with the veterans. There are also plans for Victoria and Nastya to return for future training, and one day for Becky and Denise to visit their program in Ukraine.

In essence, Victory Center will be an international extension of the work done at Carousel Ranch using equestrian therapy as a core component to address trauma, anxiety and stress. Today, Victory Center is serving two veterans and planning to start their first child in the months to come – similar to how we began with one student and one horse in Becky's backyard. Despite being on two different continents – the connection is strong and we have nothing but confidence in Nastya, Victoria and Victory Center and the great things that will come of this collaboration.

Nastya was selected for IVLP based on her incredible work with helping to establish the PR Army (an independent, non-profit organization) – dedicated to helping global media tell the accurate story of the war through the perspectives of Ukrainian experts, authorities and witnesses.
