


2022 ANNUAL SUMMARY

MISSION STATEMENT

Carousel Ranch is dedicated to improving the lives of children and young adults with special needs.

Through both our equestrian therapy and vocational training programs, we strive to create an atmosphere where every student can and will succeed... a place





As we look to the future we have so much to be thankful for. Emerging from what has been a very challenging few years, we have learned so much. Through it all, our students have been the driving force, inspiring us to persevere – following their example of resilience and courage that we are fortunate to see each and every day. Knowing that friends like you are by our sides, simply makes our work possible.

As our programs evolve and expand, we continue to be proud of our ability to serve our students throughout the various chapters of their lives creating an individualized program for each, continuously adapting to their specific needs and goals as they change over time. The equestrian therapy program is best suited for children from toddlers into their teens. For those who become too big to serve safely on the horse, we offer ground lessons, which is beneficial in preparing students for the RTW program as they near adulthood. The unique equestrian environment and work experiences offer many opportunities for our students to make meaningful gains in strength, balance, coordination and self-esteem as well as developing their soft skills with following directions, problem solving and teamwork to name a few.

Having options to move students through equestrian, into ground lessons if/when needed and then for many into RTW allows us to meet their needs throughout not only their childhood but into adulthood.

OUR PROGRAMS

EQUESTRIAN THERAPY

The heart and core of the program has and always will be our equestrian therapy program. At the end of 2022, we were serving 54 students per week and have plans to add several more in the months to come as we continue to re-build our staff and therapy horse teams.





"Jonah is 4 years old. He started riding at Carousel Ranch after we started noticing that he was not reaching his developmental milestones. He was not crawling or sitting without support. Jonah was getting therapy through other resources but to be honest we didn't see much improvement. One day when I was sitting at the Ranch during my older son Javier's lesson, I thought 'it's helped Javier so much! I know it will help Jonah as well'. Sure enough when he started riding for the very first time, I saw the difference it made in his little body. Soon after that Jonah started crawling. A few weeks later, walking with help and then not only walking but running. I want to say I was surprised but with all honesty I wasn't. I knew that his lessons and his amazing instructor Becky would give him the help he very much needed. He is still working on other goals that had to be paused due to the pandemic, but now that he is back at the Ranch we know we will get there. Thank you for helping my child in ways we couldn't."

To an individual with a disability, therapeutic riding takes them into a new, unexplored world, providing a sense of independence and freedom that challenges riders in ways they have seldom been challenged before.

Carousel Ranch's program design is unique. The program utilizes the sport of vaulting (gymnastics on a moving horse), English, and Western riding. Each child is served individually (no group lessons), with up to four people working with each student. The goals and benefits are different for every child, as we strive to help each achieve objectives, discover capabilities and reach new levels. Our instructors focus on the same concepts targeted in traditional forms of therapy, taking it out of a clinical setting and creating an atmosphere where therapy is disguised as fun.

An individual program is created - combining all available methods - with exercises tailored for each child's specific needs. Progress is consistently monitored and evaluated so as a child matures and develops, their program is modified to grow with them. It is these "basics" that make Carousel Ranch a rare program, with many students participating for well over a decade

WHY EQUESTRIAN THERAPY?

The movement of the horse causes an inherent response, relaxing muscles that are tight, increasing tone in muscles that are weak, building balance, coordination and control, increasing motor skills, improving behavior and sensory processing while building confidence, self-esteem and social interaction.



READY TO WORK (RTW!)

At age 22 (and sometimes before), young adults with special needs "age out" of the educational system. This can be a disorienting event that alters their routine, isolates them from friends and mentors leaving them without a daily purpose and place to be. Finding and securing employment can be very difficult. Ready to Work! is helping to change that scenario, bridging the gap and breaking down barriers to employment. In this way we aim to help these young people find their direction and a path that best suits their personal interests and strengths.

RTW! UTILIZES A UNIQUE TWO-COMPONENT APPROACH

All levels are based on spending more than half of the time in experiential learning and the reminder in the classroom.

LEVEL 1

A 15-week program focusing on the "soft-skills" needed to be a good employee such as teamwork, appropriate behavior, communication, flexibility, having a positive attitude, etc. These are essential skills needed to not only get a job, but to be successful in keeping it. Students complete a resume, learn and practice interview skills and finish far "readier to work." Curriculum is then brought to life by participating in various experienced-based work tasks on the grounds of Carousel Ranch and in the community. Experiences are varied including horse/ranch care, vehicle washing, events, construction, office work, retail, food service and work within our "Ready to Grow" garden.

Following completion of Level 1 - many students continue with...

LEVEL 2

This 1:1 component works to further individual efforts to secure employment, volunteer work, enrolling in continued education/training, learn personal finance, further their ability to use public transportation and, for some, even getting their driver's license. Our students work with their instructor at an individual pace towards accomplishing their unique objectives. Their instructor helps them set goals while creating a space to explore new things! Additionally, when students are placed into jobs or a volunteer position, our RTW! staff is available to help ensure students are transitioning well into their new role. Ready to Work! offers Competitive Integrated Employment and Paid Internship Programs through North Los Angeles County Regional Center, with the goal of ensuring students are successful.



READY TO WORK! ACADEMY AT COLLEGE OF THE CANYONS

RTW Academy at College of the Canyons is changing the face of postsecondary education for young adults with special needs. Certificate based courses include subjects such as Customer Service (Retail, Food Service & Hospitality), Warehouse Fulfillment & Logistics, Culinary Arts (with more in development). Following our two component approach from Level 1, courses encompass both weekly classroom instruction at COC and practicum/work experience at partner businesses in the community. These classes help the students to get a closer look at employment fields they may want to enter into, as well as a piece of experience to add to their resume.

ETHAN'S FAMILY





In July of 1997, Carousel Ranch was started by Becky Graham and Denise Redmond. The program began with one student (Kimi) and one horse in Becky's neighbor's backyard. It seems like just yesterday, when we were running the program out of an equestrian center where we shared the arena with boarders and other trainers. With 10, and then 20 students, the days were short and life was relatively simple. We didn't even have an office, using a converted barn stall for our one filing cabinet and phone. When we got our office trailer, we thought we had really made it big.

Between 1997 and 2005, Carousel Ranch operated out of five locations! After leaving the backyard in fall of 1997, the program moved to the Sylmar Equestrian Center, then to a private home off of Polk Street. From there we landed in our first Santa Clarita location, at Atlasta Ranch in Placerita Canyon. After four years, we moved to Ravenhill Road in Sand Canyon.

Our dream of a permanent home became a reality in October 2005, as we were finally able to find and buy our incredible 10+ acre ranch in Agua Dulce.

From the beginning, building a covered arena has been a dream and vision for the staff and board of Carousel Ranch. Friends and supporters rallied together to make our dream a reality. In 2014, after years of work on the campaign and building project, the program's long awaited area is everything we dared to imagine (and so much more).

In 2015, the incredible gift of \$100,000 made by Supervisor Antonovich, allowed us to officially start our new "Ready to Work!" program. Prior to this donation, we had been integrating vocational training into our curriculum with some of our older students on a very limited basis. What started with five students working informally on the ranch is now a fully operating vocational training program. This program has two components including a classroom based curriculum which is then brought to life through actual work in the "Tack Shack" storefront, run by the students, as well as various jobs around the ranch.

Sometimes it is hard to believe that so many years have passed since we started Carousel Ranch in 1997. So much has happened, and today - the Ranch is so much more than we ever dared to dream. Our hopes and dreams for Carousel Ranch continue to grow and change through the years. One thing, however - has never changed and that is our love and passion for the work that we do here. The children are our inspiration, and there is nothing that we love more than being with each and every one of them, and being a part of their successes.



OUR HORSES

Our team is made up of 14 amazing horses comprised of all sizes and breeds. From a miniature horse and miniature donkey (used to teach grooming and horse care) to our large draft horses (used for students who need an instructor behind them or simply a larger horse)...and every size/type in between. And three retired horses who have earned their golden years through their incredible service to countless children. Sadly we lost four amazing therapy horses over the past year. We welcomed our newest horses - Coco, Josie and Mattie to the team!



FUN HORSE FACTS

- Did you know that Carousel Ranch's horses can eat up to 50 pounds of carrots per lesson day? That's a total of over 800 pounds per month!!!
- Horseshoeing costs between \$65 and \$250 per horse every 6-8 weeks.
- The Ranch spends about \$10,000 per year on shoeing!
- Fly Control costs the ranch over \$300 per month!
- Routine Veterinary Costs come to approximately \$10,000 per year.
- When a horse is sick...a typical vet bill runs between \$400-\$600.
- Vaccines & Worming alone cost \$2,500 per year.
- Horse Feed, Supplies & Supplements cost the ranch over \$35,000/year!
- Every 4-5 months we order a feed trailer of "cubes". With horse feed skyrocketing the last two years, each load is running between \$12,000-\$14,000. 50% of the horses eat hay as well and all have supplements.

IN TOTAL, IT COSTS ABOUT \$4,000 PER THERAPY HORSE PER YEAR.

may sound like a lot but it is a small price to pay for the work that these amazing horses do each and every day! They are the literal backbone of Carousel Ranch.

OUR STUDENTS

Though just a few years ago we were half and half, in 2022 we served 64% boys and 36% girls. They come from all over...with 79% residing in the Santa Clarita Valley and the other 21% ranging from throughout the greater Los Angeles area including Acton. Arleta, Sylmar, La Crescenta, Montebello, San Gabriel, Van Nuys, Granada Hills and into the Antelope Valley.







DISABILITIES SERVED

Carousel Ranch sees more children within the autism spectrum than any other diagnosis.

VOLUNTEERS, STAFF & BOARD



 2022 Annual Revenue


