LEVEL 1

We completed four Level 1 classes in 2022 and one class that will wrap up their session in February 2023. Totaling 15 students we have served within the Level 1 program. Each student in this program comes to Carousel Ranch for 15 weeks to enhance their skills and learn the basics of employment. Within the program, our students get to partake in a wide variety of work experiences. This year the students refurbished benches, put on Tack Sales, groomed horses, conducted and grew many different veggies and car washes, plants in the greenhouse (including, cucumbers, cherry tomatoes and wild flowers). In addition, the students worked at a variety of events including Carousel Ranch's Annual Heart of the West and Concerts in the Park. We find these experiences valuable for our students who are starting out in the program. They are eager to learn about different jobs within the community and ways they can use their skills to make a difference.

We currently have one Level 1 class in session on Saturday (3 students), and are starting 2 more in March. The Saturday class began in October and have already participated in several work tasks including cleaning up donated tack to sell in the Tack Shack, planting California wildflowers in our Ready to Grow! greenhouse, and painting pumpkins for our annual Express Pumpkin Carving Contest! They look forward to finishing their class and moving onto the next step. Many of the students who completed Level 1 this year have moved into our Level 2 and/or Academy program. We love watching our students discover their skills!


LEVEL 2

RTW! TACK SALES

At Carousel Ranch, we strive to find meaningful off-sites where the students can practice some of the job skills they have learned in class. Rosewood Equestrian Center in Santa Clarita has been an amazing place for our students to show off what they have learned! Students plan the tack sale event by gathering, cleaning, and inventorying the donated tack to be taken, participate in the tack sale by providing customer service and running

transactions, and help with clean up after the event. These tack sales allow students to get first-hand experience selling merchandise to people they are unfamiliar with. Students practice their planning and execution skills while working this event and have expressed how useful it is to get hands-on experiences like these. We are forever grateful for Rosewood Equestrian for providing the space for our students to learn and thrive! As always, all proceeds go right back into the Ready to Work! Program.

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READY TO WORK! ACADEMY



Carousel Ranch's Ready to Work! Academy program... strong! Our two spring classes graduated at College of the Canyons in August (pictured right). Our students successfully completed their certification in Customer Service or Warehouse Management and Fulfillment. This was the second graduation of we have hosted for our Academy students.

We are currently offering certification-based courses in Customer Service as well as Warehouse, Logistics and Fulfillment. Student participation includes both a classroom portion at COC, alongside a practicum/work experience. We started a new Customer Service class in October. For this cohort, students started at Holiday Inn Express and will finish at Pet Supplies Plus. We are so thankful for our partners for turning this program into a fulfilling, experience-based course!

In the coming months, we will be offering new classes and curriculums to students who have completed our Level 1 program. We cannot wait for the continued development of this program and success of our students!









The current cohort is in their 13th week of class and have gained so much knowledge about the nuances of Customer Service during their classroom time as well as their practicum sites at Holiday Inn Express and Pet Supplies Plus. We find having work experience partners allows the students to become familiar with different work environments and businesses they could work for in the future. For example, at Holiday Inn Express, the students worked in the various different departments including housekeeping, the front desk, and food service. This hands-on learning allows the students to incorporate the material learned in class at their practicum site. The continuation of this program is made possible by Los Angeles County Supervisor Kathryn Barger. In the future, we hope to offer classes on culinary and automotive! We appreciate all of the support from families & students, as well as the continued support from our community!

We saw so much progress with Emma through the program. She was opening up, feeling less anxious, making friendships and learned how to work as a team, the importance of being patient, and the value of respect. All the traits we need in the workforce.
