Insurance documentation For Power Wheelchair

- ★ The patient has mobility issues that imparis them to perform acts of daily living.
- ★ The patient's mobility can not be resolved by the use of a cane or walker.
- ★ The patient does not have sufficient upper extremity function to propel a standard or lightweight Wheelchair.
- ★ The patient does not meet the criteria for an electric scooter.
- ★ The patient is willing and able to safely operate the Power wheelchair.
- ★ The patient home provided adequate access between rooms to use the Power chair.
- ★ The use of a power wheelchair will improve the patient's ability to perform acts of daily living and will be used in the home.
- ★ Patient has not expressed an unwillingness to use a power wheelchair in the home.
