Toothbrush and Toothpaste Shampoo and Conditioner Deodorant Liquid Body Wash Wash Cloth Bug Spray Sun Screen (SPF 30 or higher) Flashlight (with batteries if needed) Water Bottle Permanent Marker and Masking Tape Prayer Letter Rain Poncho

Please put each "pack" into a drawstring backpack.

- ★ For gendered items (like deodorant) please include 5 male and 5 female packs. Please label the bags if possible.
- ★ Please make all toiletries full sized.
- ★ Prayer letters are an opportunity to tell a Special Session camper that they are loved, and to wish them a happy week of camp. These letters can mean the world to our campers. We are not able to give camper names in advance, so please write to "Dear Camper".

For Special Session 2025, we are looking for 9 churches or church groups in the diocese to create 10 welcome packs, to serve a total of 90 campers (always good to have extra).
