Funeral Care and Grief Support Ministry

- o Prepare food, host funeral receptions
- o Usher, parking assistance for funeral services
- o Arrange flowers for funeral receptions
- o Visit, support those who grieve
- o Help facilitate Grief Support Workshop

Divorce Support Ministry

- o Help facilitate Divorce Recovery Workshop
- o Visit, support families in divorce

New Baby Ministry

- o Prepare and deliver a meal to family with infant
- o Visit, support family with newborn

Flower Team Ministry

- o Grow or purchase flowers to donate to ministry
- o Arrange and deliver flowers as needed

Prayer Team Ministry

- o Receive and pray about joys and concerns
- o Create prayer shawls, quilts

6. Children's Ministries

- o Share vision as member of Children's Ministry Council
- o Join a teaching team for Sunday School
- o Substitute teach in Sunday School, as needed
- o Help plan/coordinate an event Advent Workshop, Holy Week Walk, Wonderfully Made, VBS
- o Provide specific help during events set up, supplies, leading groups, publicity, food, station aid, etc.
- o Engage 5th graders in a service project (FISH)
- o Make Children First happen! plan, recruit, supply, set-up, or coach the children in practice
- o Refresh the children's activity kits in the sanctuary
- o Share computer skills for data entry
- o Organize/monitor ministry supplies and storage areas

7. Youth Ministries

- o Teach "Sunday Connect" for Middle or High School
- o Lead worship, discussion at Sunday afternoon Youth Group
- o Support monthly social/service events (drive, chaperone)
- o Provide food for special events, as needed
- o Chaperone youth on out-of-town day or mission trips
- o Develop 1-1 relationship with student in confirmation process
- o Teach a session of Confirmation Class on a specific topic
 - Partner to pray for a youth in confirmation or on a mission trip
- o Manage forms, email lists and mailings to support ministry
