What is Magic Mouthwash?

Magic Mouthwash is a special prescription rinse used to treat **mouth pain, sores, and inflammation**. It's often used for people undergoing cancer treatments, or those with infections, mouth ulcers, or other causes of oral discomfort.

It contains a mix of ingredients like:

- Anesthetic (e.g., lidocaine) numbs the mouth to reduce pain
- **Antihistamine** or **anticholinergic** (e.g., diphenhydramine) reduces swelling and discomfort
- Antacid or coating agent (e.g., Maalox) helps the medication coat the mouth
- May also contain antibiotic, antifungal, or steroid, depending on your needs

Your specific formulation may vary based on your doctor's prescription.



How to Use Magic Mouthwash

- 1. Shake the bottle well before each use.
- 2. Measure the dose usually 5 to 10 mL (1–2 teaspoons), as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.
- 3. Swish and hold in your mouth for 1–2 minutes.
- 4. Spit it out, unless told to swallow it. (Most formulas are NOT meant to be swallowed.)
- 5. Do not eat or drink anything for at least 30 minutes after use to allow the medicine to work.
- 6. Use it as often as prescribed, usually every 4–6 hours

Important Tips

- Store in the refrigerator, if advised.
- Do not share with others.
- Use within the time frame specified on the label or by your pharmacy.
- Let your doctor or pharmacist know if:
 - o Your symptoms worsen
 - You feel numb for too long
 - You experience an allergic reaction (rash, itching, trouble breathing)

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I swallow it?

A: Most versions are not meant to be swallowed. Only swallow if your doctor specifically instructs you to.

O: Is it safe for children?

A: Only use in children if prescribed by a pediatrician
