

## FAQ

What will the Medicine Shoppe bring to the clinic?

- Vaccines, supplies, and safety materials along with information sheets and enough staff to perform the clinic.
- Prior to the clinic we will provide a sign-up sheet to help schedule times for those interested and copies of the paperwork that can be filled out ahead of time to help expedite the clinic.
- We can also provide fliers to help you promote the clinic.

What happens if more people want the flu shot on the day of the clinic than originally planned?

- We will come prepared to accept more than originally scheduled. The major constraint would be time as we may have a clinic scheduled after yours at another location.

What is the minimum number of participants required?

- 5

What about insurance coverage?

- For our clinics we will bill the employer directly at a rate of \$34 per immunization. We will only bill for those employees who receive a vaccine.

How long will the clinic take?

- A clinic on average can handle 12 patients in an hour, but this number is flexible and can be adjusted based on your specific needs and the number of vaccines you need.

Can you provide vaccines to people who work the overnight shift?

- Yes. We can work with you to provide immunizations to all your staff.

What does my site need to provide?

- All we need from you is a private area to work with a table, a few chairs, and a trash can. We will leave the room as clean as we found it and we will take away all the trash we make.

Can pregnant women still receive the flu shot?

- Absolutely and it is recommended.

How much notice do you need to set up your flu clinic?

- We ask for 2 weeks to arrange a clinic, but the earlier you schedule, the less likely we will have a prior commitment at your desired time.
