



Coronavirus Policy

Pharma340 staff understands the growing concern surrounding coronavirus (COVID-19) across our communities, and our hearts go out to all those who've been impacted.

Caring for our patients and team members is our top priority and we are taking the growing concerns around the coronavirus (COVID-19) very seriously. We are closely monitoring updates from the U.S Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the World Health Organization and other local public health agencies to determine the safest course of action for everyone who enters our stores.

In addition to our current industry-leading health and safety practices, we are taking additional steps to keep our patients safe during this uncertain time. Our associates follow regular cleaning practices using a disinfectant formulated to kill coronavirus, among other germs. Plus, Pharma340 will continue to adhere to the following general precautions as recommended by the CDC to prevent the spread of communicable diseases:

- Emphasize proper hand hygiene utilizing soap and water for 20 seconds when possible and frequent use of alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Exercise proper respiratory etiquette covering cough with elbow and washing hands if necessary.
- Emphasize that people avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Routinely clean and disinfect surfaces and frequently touched objects in the pharmacy during the day and before leaving in the evening using cleaning spray or wipes.
- Emphasize that people get a flu shot to protect themselves and others from the flu, which has similar symptoms to COVID-19.
- Requiring that sick employees stay home.
- Requiring 14-day quarantine for staff who have had personal air travel to CDC risk-assessed areas.
- Not handling vials brought into the pharmacy by patients.
- Requesting that all patients to return to their vehicles while prescriptions are filled and we will call them when ready.
- During an outbreak, we will keep the front doors of the pharmacy locked and require patients to utilize the drive-through window.

As this situation continues to evolve quickly we will be monitoring it closely. Based on current guidance and our own standards and practices, we will remain open for business and are committed to providing a safe experience for you and your families.
