

Getting Started with Decorative Street Signs

The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) sets standards for road signs. Many municipalities also have their own regulations for sizes and types of signs. We strongly recommend that you contact your local authority to make sure you comply with all requirements. Below are some questions you may find helpful as you get started.

Normally you can find this information by contacting your municipality's Public Works or Engineering department.

There may be different size signs required for the same project depending on the speed limit.

For example, some streets may require a 30" stop sign in one location and a 24" stop sign in another.
