Tasting Note

Light garnet hue with sweet and savory aromas of fresh lilac, dried plum, wild strawberry, cumin and manuka smoked bacon. The charming florals, intriguing spice and red/dried fruit flavors layer wonderfully with the limey acidity that drives the wine and the silky fine tannins that create a beautiful round and mouth filling texture. Forever ethereal, Waitaki Pinot is unique: bridging the energy of new world pinot with the form and shape of classic old world pinot noir. An intriguing wine that is lithe and fragrant in its youth with savory notes that will continue to unfold with age.
