



Valli Bendigo Vineyard Pinot Noir 2018

95 Points

This delivers a pretty perfume of fresh-ripe red fruit with a pinch of black berry/cherry emerging, and no obvious oak influence. The palate is dense and juicy, really succulent and lively, driving desire for additional sips. Tannins are fine-grained, firm but not angular, and acids are perfectly comfortable. Excellent length. Fine wine; drink or hold into the late '20s. Tasted August 2019.

Valli Gibbston Vineyard Pinot Gris 2018

91 Points

14% alcohol. A pinot Gris in the ripe and lush style with high intensity aromatics, exotic fruit, floral, rosewater, orange and tangerine zest/essential oil - plenty of terpenes, in other words. The palate is large-scaled and structured, broad but not overly fat - a seam of ripe acids keep this on the rails. A very nice example. Drink or hold 2-4 years. Tasted August 2019.
