In 2019, that was reflected in a meager average bunch weight of just 45 grams –that's tiny. Unsurprisingly, the resulting wine has intense concentration wrapped up in a midweight, elegant frame. The aromas are distinctive – quite unlike anything you'd find in Central Otago – offering paprika, smoked meats, dried herbs and tapenade as well as ripe cherry fruit. It concludes by providing a precise, lengthy finish with a chalky, almost salty tannic texture.
