Tasting Notes:

Very perfumed and aromatically expressive, ripe white peach stone fruit, some floral /honeysuckle notes in background.

Great concentrated core of ripe fruit on front palate balanced by typical Riesling acidity which bursts out of the middle of the fruit carrying flavours with it giving the wine great length.

These are some of the oldest wine grapevines in the South Island and consequently have the root mass to fully ripen the fruit and add complexity from the soil.

Alexandra, having the country's greatest diurnal temperature range also helps the grapes ripen during the hot days but retain their acidity and vibrancy during the cooler nights.
