OVERVIEW

The premium tour at the Oklahoma Hall of Fame focuses on a wide range of Oklahomans that have influenced our state in many different ways. Included in the tour are several Oklahomans mentioned in the Oklahoma Academic Standards (OAS) for third grade. We have created this lesson plan to be used before and after your tour.

RESEARCH PAPER

- Research an Oklahoma Hall of Fame member before you come on tour! This can be done individually or in groups. Using the Oklahoma Hall of Fame member archives on the following website, <https://oklahomahof.com/member-archives>, allow students to research a notable Oklahoman that they have something in common with. Use the worksheet provided with this lesson to gather the following information.
- After your tour when you return to the classroom, give students time to make notes from the tour about their selected individual. Then, using both the research they did ahead of time and what they learned on their tour, have students write a 1 page paper about an Oklahoma Hall of Fame member. If this is a group project, divide the writing into sections by paragraph (one student writing about childhood, another writing about career, awards, contributions to Oklahoma, etc.).
