

Camp changes since 2020

NEW Requirements for churches, sponsors, or parents:

- Each church should bring 2 new mops (girls and guys dorms) in order to mop your dormitory bathroom for daily sanitization. The new mops for each session of camp will help greatly with sanitization.
- Churches will be required to bring at least one thermometer to share with males and females in your church group, or 2 thermometers to have one per cabin. Adult sponsors in cabins will be responsible for daily temperature checks and logging. The camp will provide the daily log sheet. This will need to be submitted to the camp nurse daily.
- Adult sponsors will be required to enforce health and safety rules within your church group.
- Parents will need to be available to come and get their camper at any point during their stay if there is sufficient evidence of a contagious illness.
- No outside visitors will be allowed at camp this summer.
- Churches will need to provide a list of at least one contact parent / guardian for each camper along with phone number and email. This will allow us to quickly communicate with parents if there is a suspected illness.

Changes for camp:

- Cashless retail system We will be selling punch cards to be used at the concession, general store, and smoothie. This will cut down on the handling of cash. The cards can be purchased online through our website, or at camp. Cards can be purchased in increments of \$5, \$10, \$15, and \$20.
- Handwashing sinks available Several handwashing stations will be added to the camp.
 Everyone will be required to wash hands before entering the dining hall.
- Face coverings are recommended, but not required within church groups. Face coverings are strongly recommended if social distancing is not feasible when contacting someone from another group.
- Camp staff will be serving all food and creating as much a "touch free" dining space as possible.

Suggestions for churches:

In order to make your church, campers, or parents feel safer, you are welcome (but not required) to bring the following:

- Personal flotation devices (approved vest style life jacket for the pond)
- Cases of bottled water
- Sports balls that can be used by your own group
- Extra face coverings
- Sanitizer and disinfectant wipes for your cabin
